District Day is a program designed to provide training opportunities for our undergraduate and alumnae members across the country. District Day is the best opportunity for collegiate chapters, colonies and alumnae chapters to send a large number of members to a national Alpha Sigma Alpha event. It is also a great way for individual members who may not be involved with an alumnae chapter or as a volunteer to reconnect with the national sorority. This is where members can find out all the exciting things that Alpha Sigma Alpha has been doing and how members can get involved.

There will be programming for everyone!

- Collegians will engage in more than four hours of training programs to increase knowledge and skills in areas such as recruitment, leadership development, finance, member education, standards and chapter management.
- Alumnae will have the opportunity to participate in professional and self-development workshops, as well as round table discussions on new national alumnae programs.

Who should attend?

Collegiate chapters located within 300 miles of Philadelphia are required to send a delegation of 15 members—minimum \$525. This includes all chapters in District 2 – Nu Nu, Delta Epsilon, Delta Iota, Delta Chi, Epsilon Kappa, Epsilon Tau, Zeta Theta, Zeta Iota, Zeta Lambda and Zeta Nu.

We encourage alumnae participation whether you are involved with an alumnae chapter or not. Alumnae chapters are encouraged to send a delegation, as it is one of the optional criteria to achieve Palm, Star or Crown Recognition.

How much does it cost?

Registration is \$35 a person. Participants may pre-order a District Day black, short-sleeved T-shirt with the District Day logo for \$10 (T-shirt design enclosed). Alpha Sigma Alpha merchandise and items from may be available for sale as well. Alpha Sigma Alpha car magnets will also be available for purchase.

What is covered by the registration fee?

Each participant will receive continental breakfast and lunch on Saturday, conference materials and a small District Day gift.
