

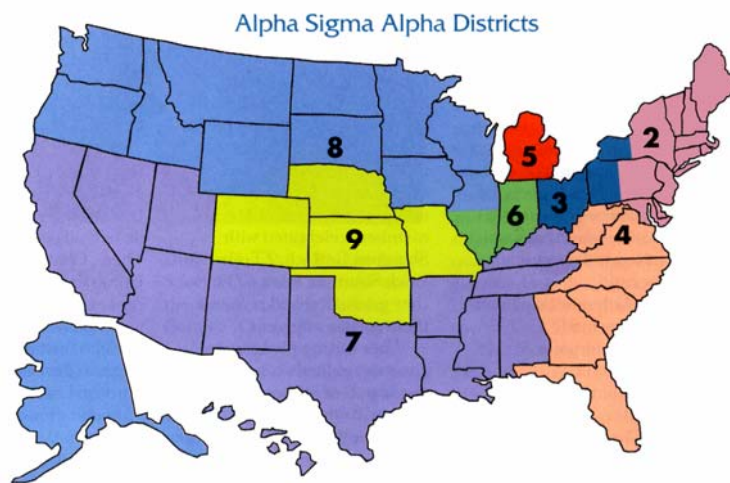
What is the purpose of the district structure?

What are the districts?



What is a district team?

A district team is a group of alumnae volunteers charged with supporting the collegiate and alumnae chapters within a specific district.

What is the goal of the district team?

To ensure that every chapter in the district has access to the resources they need to be successful.

How is the district team structured?

The team includes three Coaching Teams, each charged with understanding and supporting chapters in a specific area: Finance, Education, or Recruitment.

The District Facilitator serves as the primary conduit between the chapters and the district resources available to them. She may also serve as a conduit between the district chapters and national teams and resources.

When should I contact the district?

For assistance with any aspect of chapter operations, including issues with finances (Billhighway, budgeting, debt), recruitment (planning, events), or education (*ΑΣΑ Advantage*, FIPG, Ritual, Philanthropy).

Why would I talk to the district instead of an advisor?

The district volunteers are an additional resource for you and your advisory board. You might contact us if an advisor is unavailable or an advisory board position is vacant. You and your advisor may decide together to contact the district for assistance with a specific national policy or other complex issue.
